## NATIONAL GUARD ASSOCIATION OF NEW JERSEY ANNUAL AWARDS PROGRAM

#### 1. OUTSTANDING COMPANY GRADE OFFICER- ARMY AND AIR

- a. Major Commands are to consolidate nominations for the Major General James F. Cantwell Outstanding Company Grade Officer- Army and Air Award for Calendar Year **2023** and forward to the awards chair listed below.
- b. This award is given annually by this association to recognize the most outstanding company grade officer from the NJ Army Guard, and the most outstanding company grade officer from the NJ Air Guard. The format for recommendations is provided in Annex A of the NGANJ Awards Program. Major Commands and their subordinate units are as follows (number of nominations in parenthesis):
- c. Eligible Officers must be an active regular member of the National Guard Association of New Jersey in the grades of 0-1, 0-2, or 0-3, who are not members of the NGANJ Executive Council, and who have not previously won this award.
- d. Nominations for Army National Guard officers will be submitted THRU the Major Command Commander (Chief of Staff, JFHQ for JFHQ nominee) to the NGANJ Awards Committee Chairman. Nominations for Air National Guard officers will be submitted THRU NJANG/CC to the NGANJ Awards Committee Chairman. **ALL NOMINATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NLT 01 March 2024.**
- d. During the April time frame a *Selection Board* to consider nominations will review and assess the packets of the nominations. The Army Major Commands indicated above are requested to select one (1) field grade officer (each) to serve on the Board. JFHQ Air Component is requested to select two (2) field grade officers to serve on the Board. The names of the officers selected, along with their home address, and home and work telephone numbers will be submitted to the Awards Committee Chairman.

## 2. THE MAJOR GENERAL FRANCIS R. GERARD TROPHY ARMY AND AIR

- a. Major Commands are to consolidate nominations for the Major General Francis R. Gerard Trophy for Calendar Year 2023 forward to the awards chair listed below.

This award is given annually to recognize the most outstanding individual on flying status for performance of rated and assigned duties which includes one or more of the following criteria: a) heroic act involving lifesaving, or possible life-threatening situation during flight activities; b) heroic act involving saving aircraft, facilities or personnel during flight activities; c) outstanding participation in unit exercises, deployment and/or training. Major Commands and their number of nominations in parenthesis are as follows:

- c. Any active regular member of the National Guard Association of New Jersey on flying status, in any grade is eligible for consideration. The format for recommendations is provided in Annex C of the NGANJ Awards Program.
- d. Nominations for Army flyers will be submitted THRU the Major Command Commander (Chief of Staff, JFHQ for JFHQ nominee) to the NGANJ Awards Committee Chairman. Nominations for Air flyers will be submitted THRU NJANG/CC to the NGANJ Awards Committee Chairman. <u>ALL NOMINATIONS</u> <u>MUST BE RECEIVED NLT 01 March 2024.</u>
- e. A Selection Board to consider nominations will be convened at the Joint Training & Training Development Center, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey in **February timeframe**. Nominees will be notified to appear before the Board. The Army Major Commands indicated above are requested to select one (1) rated pilot (each) to serve on the Board. JFHQ Air Component is requested to select two (2) rated pilots to serve on the Board. The senior member will be the President, and the junior member the Recorder. The names of the officers selected, along with their home address, and home and work telephone numbers will be submitted to the Awards Committee Chairman NLT 01 March 2024.

- c. Nominations for Army National Guard officers will be submitted THRU the Major Command Commander (Chief of Staff, JFHQ for JFHQ nominee) to the NGANJ Awards Committee Chairman. Nominations for Air National Guard officers will be submitted THRU NJANG/CC to the NGANJ Awards Committee Chairman. ALL NOMINATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NLT 01 March 2024.
- d. A *Selection Board* to consider nominations will be convened at the Joint Training & Training Development Center, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey in **the February** *timeframe*.
